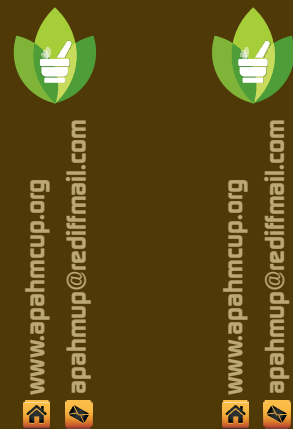

## GENERAL

- (i) In accordance with the guidelines/ principles laid down in order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in T.M.A Pai Foundation and others Vs. State of Karnataka and Others, Writ Petition no 317 of 1993 delivered on 31.10.2002, and thereafter in the case of Islamic Academy of Education versus State of Karnataka and others delivered on 14.08.2003, on behalf of **Association of Private Ayurvedic/Unani & Homoeopathic Medical Colleges, U.P.**, would be conducting Common Pre Medical Entrance Examination -2014 to offer admission to the B.A.M.S./B.H.M.S. Courses. The duration of the course will be four and a half years followed by one year of compulsory Rotatory Internship (Non Paid). The curriculum is based on the directives of Central Council of Indian Medicine and Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi.

### Eligibility Criteria:

**Age :** Only those candidates whose date of birth falls on or before **31st December 1997 (at least 17 years of age on 31st Dec 2014)** are eligible to apply. Date of Birth as recorded in the High School or its equivalent certificate alone will be accepted.

### Reservation :

Reservation Policy as per U.P. Govt. entitlement.

### Qualification and Minimum Marks:

#### B.A.M.S./B.H.M.S.

The candidates who have passed the 10+2 i.e. I.S.C./Intermediate examination or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be eligible.

The candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in the qualifying examination. for all categories.

The candidates who are appearing for the qualifying examination (XII) and result is not yet available are also eligible to appear in the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination but such candidates shall submit the mark sheet of the qualifying examination (XII) on or before **27th July 2014**.

**Note :** Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Directives & Punishable under law



### Scope of Examination and Evaluation

The pattern and syllabus will follow the CPMT Examination as conducted by Govt. of UP.

- All candidates should appear for the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination. The entrance examination will comprise of an objective type examination of 180 minutes duration containing 230 questions. The distribution of questions for subjects will be Eng./Hindi 30 (English section is compulsory for B.H.M.S. aspirants and Hindi section for B.A.M.S. applicants), Physics 40, Chemistry 60 and Biology 100. The syllabus for entrance examination will be as per the 10+2 examination (CBSE/ICSE/U.P.BOARD or its equivalent). The question paper will be in English & Hindi both.
- All the questions will be objective type with multiple (A,B,C,D) choice of which, only one will be the most appropriate response and, therefore, the correct choice. Each correct answer shall be awarded ONE mark. ZERO marks shall be given to no response and incorrect answers. More than one choice indicated against a question shall be considered as incorrect response and ZERO mark will be given. There will be no negative marking.

### (iii) Answering Method.

- The answer sheet will be placed inside the sealed Examination Booklet. The seal will be opened by the candidate after being instructed by the Supervising Examiner/Invigilator and only then the answer sheet is to be taken out. Do not open /break the seal before the announcement.
- Side II of the Answer Sheet will have a pre-printed Examination Booklet Code A, B, C or D.
- The candidates are required to check that the Examination Booklet Code pre-printed on Side-II of the answer sheet is the same as printed on the Examination booklet.
- The format of the answer sheet that will be found placed inside the Examination Booklet is given in Appendix-I. Candidates are advised to go through it carefully and be conversant with the requirements of giving particulars and marking the answers.
- The answer sheet used will be of special type and will be scanned by Optical Scanner. There will be two sides to the Answer Sheet.
- Side-I. This side of the Answer Sheet contains the following columns which are to be filled in neatly and accurately by the candidate with Blue/Black ball point pen only: Roll Number, Test Booklet number, Centre Code, Course Code, name of the candidate and signature of the candidate.
- Side -II. This side of the Answer Sheet contains the following columns which are also to be filled in by the candidate with Blue/Black Ball Point Pen only i.e. Roll Number, Test Booklet number, Centre Code, Course Code. Write and mark your Roll Number and examination Booklet Number as per specimen Answer Sheet.

Question 001 to 230 : On side II of the answer sheet , **fully darken only one circle using HB Pencil for each answer** as shown in the example on side I of the answer sheet. If you darken more than one circle your answer will be treated as wrong.

Candidate should not indicate the answer in any other way (i.e., tick mark, cross, dot line etc. are not accepted). Please do not make any stray marks on the answer sheet.

If More than one circle is darkened, or if the response is marked in wrong manner, it shall be treated as a wrong answer.

If candidate wants to change any answer on the answer sheet, he/she must erase completely the existing pencil mark, and then darken the appropriate circle with pencil.

Candidate must ensure that no visible mark is left after erasing the wrong answer.

Candidate should not do any rough work or writing work on the answer sheet. All rough work should be done in the Examination Booklet.

The order of question is not the same in all Examination Booklets; the pages are jumbled. So, candidates should not change their Examination Booklet during the examination. If you do so, your answers would be marked wrong.

- The candidates will have to secure a minimum of 50% marks for qualifying the test. For all category

- A candidate seeking admission to the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination BAMS/BHMS is required to send his/her application on the prescribed form appended in the information brochure. A candidate should not fill in more than one form for the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination :2014-15.
- Before filling up the Application Form the candidate must familiarize himself/herself with the information given in this brochure and should satisfy his/her eligibility to appear in the examination. The candidate is required to go through the Information brochure carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all requirements with regard to the filling-in of the Application form.
- Application Form should be filled in English only.
- The candidate shall fill-up the Application Form in his/her own handwriting in block letters written neatly and legibly with blue/black in within the prescribed boxes. Overwriting, cutting, erasing in the application forms may lead to rejection of the form and should be avoided. Any error arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidate. (it is advisable to first fill in a photocopy of the form and then fill in the main document.)
- The candidate should write his/her complete address in the Application Form for further correspondence. Pin Code should be given in the space provided for Pin-Code. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he/she fill-in his/her correct address in the application form. Association/Colleges shall not be held responsible for any loss in transit or for an incorrect address given by the applicant on the application form.
- The last date of receipt of completed Application Form is **19th July, 2014.**
- Please fill in the Application Form number on the envelope (in the space provided) and ensure that it should reach positively by **19th July 2014** to the concerned colleges. In case of B.H.M.S. 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- Photograph : Affix a recent (not taken before 30.03.2014) Coloured photograph(preferably black and white) in the space provided for it on the Application Form. The Photograph should be firmly affixed to the Application Form. Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photograph are liable to be rejected. Candidates are required to put their signature in the box given at the bottom of the Photograph. Writing full name in this box in Capital letters would not be accepted as signature and the Application Form is liable to be rejected.
- Candidate should firmly tie or staple together his/her Application Form and enclosures, if any. (Use the envelope provided for dispatch of Application Form.)
- Request for change in any particulars in the Application Form shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- Incomplete Application Forms or with over-writing will be rejected.
- Submission of more than One Application Form : Candidates are required to submit only One Application Form. If a candidate submits more than one Application Form, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.

**The application form must be accompanied with :**

- Attested photocopy of High School / ICSE/Class X or its equivalent pass certificate as proof of date of birth.
- Attested photocopy of the mark sheets of the qualifying examination (10+2 or its equivalent) from a recognized Board/ University.  
 Furnishing of false information or suppression of any information would disqualify the candidate from the Common Pre-Medical Entrance examination/admission and cancellation of admission if already admitted. If considered necessary, legal action may also be taken against such a candidate.

- **ADMIT CARD :** The Admit Card will be sent to the candidate by Speed Post/Courier. In case the Admit Card is not received by **23rd July 2014**, the candidate should contact the concerned college where the application was sent with a Photograph (as pasted in the Application Form), Photo copy of Application form for getting duplicate Admit Cards.

- The Admit Card will bear the candidate's roll number, examination centre code and address, candidate's name, address, photograph and signature. The candidate should carefully examine the Admit Card received by him/her for all the entries made therein. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should immediately inform the concerned college where the application was sent.

Entry to the examination hall will be restricted to candidates not in possession of Admit Card. In no case, would a duplicate Admit Card be issued at the Examination Centres.

Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Cards in good condition till admission in the college(s). Those who claim to be considered in the "weaker sections" shall produce the appropriate document at the time of counseling/interview. The Performa/criteria will be specified by the examination committee later.

#### COMMON PRE-MEDICAL ENTRANCE EXAMINATION BAMS/ BHMS 2014-15

- The Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination BAMS/ BHMS 2014-15 will be held on **27th July, 2014** (Sunday) from 10.00 a.m. to 1.00p.m.
- Admit Card will be sent to all eligible candidates at their postal address. The Colleges shall not be responsible for non-receipt or delay of admit cards due to loss in transit or any other ground. Admit card will not be sent to ineligible candidates and no correspondence in this regard shall be entertained nor shall the fees be refunded.
- Candidates must reach their examination centre at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination. No candidate will be allowed in the examination 15 minutes after the commencement of the examination.
- The Venue of the examination will be communicated through the Admit Card.
- Candidates should hand over the answer sheet and the question paper (Examination Booklet) to the invigilator, before leaving the examination hall.
- Candidates must bring a pen, pencil (s), sharpener and eraser with them.
- Candidates are not allowed to bring any books, text material, calculator, mobile phones, paging device, slide rulers, log tables or laptop to the examination hall.
- Any conversation or gesticulation or causing disturbance in the examination hall shall lead to debarring the candidates(s) from taking the entrance examination.
- Candidate must sign the attendance sheet in the presence of the invigilator.
- Candidate must make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging in connection with the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination BAMS/BHMS. If you live far away from the venue, it is prudent to reach the city on the previous day itself. It is also advised to locate the examination place beforehand. On the day of the examination, start early from your home/hotel and reach the Examination Centre well in advance.

**ADMISSION :** The admission of the selected candidates shall be done by the Principal/Head of the respective colleges.

- Candidate if after joining, remains absent continuously for 30 days without any intimation will be presumed not interested in pursuing the course and the seat shall be treated as vacant and allotted to the other eligible candidate.
- A candidate who had qualified for admission to the BAMS/BHMS course shall have to deposit the prescribed full fees at the time of admission. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission in the course.
- Admission in BAMS/BHMS course shall be given only after the candidate produces the original of the **following documents at the office of the Principals of the respective colleges :-**

  - All admissions are subject to verification of authenticity of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. The decision of the admission committee regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.

As per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the admissions will be closed by 30th October 2014. If any student discontinues the studies after this period or in the subsequent years or does not join the course by the stipulated date he/she is liable to pay the tuition fee for the remaining year(s). The candidate may be asked to submit a bank guarantee by the concerned institute.

#### FEE STRUCTURE :

In pursuance to the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India the fee committee constituted by the U.P.Govt. for the purpose is in the process of finalizing the fee structure and the same shall be communicated to the candidates at the time of counseling or the fee will be charge as per the fee structure already in existence as approved by the CCIM. **For BAMS the tuition fee shall be charged @ Rs 2,50,000 per annum** for the duration of four & half years. However regarding **BHMS, the U.P. Govt. has fixed the tuition fee @ 85,000/- per annum exclusive of security etc. of Rs. 20,000/-**
